The Committee has approved an updated Club Constitution for ratification at a Special General Meeting on 15 May 2021. We've prepared this handout to explain what it all means.

 Here are some common questions we've had about the update:

Why are we doing this?

What's wrong with the old one?

Who is doing this?

What is the Board/Executive??

Does this make the Committee obsolete?

 Why are we doing this?

- The last BSSLSC Constitution was ratified in 1993.
- SLSNSW has just updated its Constitution and is encouraging all Branches and Clubs to do the same using the new SLSNSW template.
- The Committee have been working on the update on and off for several years. This update has been developed by the current Constitution Subcommittee.

 What do the changes mean?

- The Club will continue to operate as it does right now, with the Executive members of the Committee to be called the “Board/Executive” to comply with SLSNSW rules.
- Members of the Board/Executive are still Committee Members and have the same vote (one) per matter as everyone else.
- The positions proposed to make up the Board/Executive are the same as the current arrangements:
 - ❖ President
 - ❖ Vice President
 - ❖ Treasurer
 - ❖ Secretary
 - ❖ Club Captain
- They will be responsible for the day-to-day management of the Club's business and functions in consultation and cooperation with the relevant members of the Committee.
