There is one small change to the previously published roster, with Patrol One now taking the ORCA shift on 1<sup>st</sup> Feb 20. ORCA Patrol was accidentally rostered on 3 weekends in a row in February. Patrol Eight still requires a Patrol Captain to be formally appointed. May be shared. Series is held over four (4) weekends and provides great exposure to a higher competition level and exposure to Sydney club competitors. Depending upon entry numbers, there</p>	

	<p>may be a requirement to provide officials and water safety people from the club. First competition day 26th October 2019.</p> <p>Discussions included developing a Broulee competition group for seniors and nippers, depending on interest and access to coaches.</p>	
5.6	<p><b>Nippers Report – (Jason Domeny)</b></p> <p><b>5.6.1</b> October long weekend marks a start to building further shelving in the nippers area of the shed. Request for \$88 to cover costs of ply to use as shelves. Advised to make purchase and present receipt to Treasurer for reimbursement. Timber for the framing has been donated by Andrew Mizzi.</p> <p><b>5.6.2</b> Request to conduct a fund raising activity involving the sale of Cadbury chocolates over the Summer holiday season. Requires a club commitment to fund the initial purchase of chocolates, which if all sold, will generate a 66% profit. Estimated 25-30 boxes required at \$36 per box.</p> <p><b>Motion:</b> that the committee approve the purchase of up to 30 boxes for Nipper families to sell over the Summer period.</p> <p><b>Moved:</b> Jason Domeny</p> <p><b>Seconded:</b> Linda McKay</p> <p><b>Carried.</b></p> <p><b>5.6.3</b> The boards that are no longer being used, will be removed from the shed. There are disused club Bennet brand, boards suitable for mounting in the club. The committee has agreed to this proposal.</p> <p><b>5.6.4</b> Board Awareness Activity: To be held Saturday 19 October 2019 from 930AM. Activity is targeted for the U9 and U14 groups who are starting board use and transitioning to the long board respectively, so they have exposure prior to starting at the beginning of nippers with no prior exposure.</p> <p><b>5.6.5</b> Wetsuits available for purchase / swap on the long weekend at the shed and again after the pool swim.</p> <p><b>5.6.6</b> Re-useable cups. 5.7	<p><b>Canberra Nippers Report</b></p> <p><b>5.7.1</b> Proficiency swims complete. ID checks for new members complete. Membership transfers begun to trickle through. Canberra Broulee Nippers is at capacity. There was an overwhelming response to new memberships. Further member enquiries have been referred to Mollymook. A number of parents have also been approached successfully to complete Officials courses. U14 and Cadets are being assessed for Bronze Medallion upgrades on 3<sup>rd</sup> November. Sufficient to meet water safety requirements.</p> <p><b>5.7.2</b> Canberra trailer quote did not originally include cost of sponsor logos. May need to request a further allocation of funding in the near future to cover the cost of this. To date all trailer costs have been met by the grant funding. Trailer is ready, other than for the logos and registration to be completed.</p> <p><b>Motion:</b> For funding of approximately \$500 to cover costs of sponsor logos applied to the Canberra trailer.</p> <p><b>Moved:</b> Steve Corcoran.</p> <p><b>Seconded:</b> Darren Drewson.</p> <p><b>Carried.</b></p>

5.9	<p><b>First Aid Report - (Melinda Brogan)</b> The battery for the Canberra training defibrillator has been ordered. Noted that Canberra oxygen therapy and first-aid equipment is being brought to Broulee for inspection.</p>	
5.10	<p><b>Power Craft Report - (Peter McKay)</b>  <b>5.9.1</b> Velcro strapping has been purchased. Boat towropes have been purchased and painted to make easier identification should they go missing. All of the material for spraying the ATV with neutraliser and rust guard agent has been acquired.  <b>5.9.2</b> Please reinforce that the last patrol of the weekend should put some (approx 40ml) <i>Saltmax</i> flush through the engines at end of patrol.  <b>5.9.3</b> Discussion had on organising a powercraft day for operators to discuss maintenance and handling. PM has indicated he will move from patrol to patrol to ensure there is a standardised approach amongst operators for maintaining the equipment. There will be no IRB proficiency held this year. SOP allow for proficiency to be demonstrated by competence during normal course of operations during patrols throughout the year. This will be managed by the Patrol Captains and supervised by the Club's IRB assessors.</p>	PM
5.11	<p><b>Boat Report (Claire Forbes.)</b>  <b>5.11.1</b> Deed of Licence for shed in Canberra was signed today for lodgement tomorrow. First quarterly payment due 1<sup>st</sup> September.  <b>5.11.2</b> Competition Fees: Chasing River Rooster Run and Warilla Boat series fees. Former was advised as paid. Latter coming in slowly.  <b>5.11.3</b> Request for Canberra crews to use clubhouse for accommodation during George Bass event. Club is not booked during January. A further club (Henley have also asked). This has been declined. Committee has approved Canberra to use the club, but agreed the facilities would not be adequate to support further crews. Of note; accommodation and caretaker facilities have been organised at Moruya High School for George Bass competitors.  <b>5.11.4</b> There is also varied opinions on how sponsorship is acquired and utilised. The committee has tasked the Boat Captain to articulate to the crews that sponsorship offers are to be forwarded to the committee, via the club secretary for presentation to the committee, per club policy. The apparent adhoc current process is leading to confusion on sponsorship agreements, promised funding and its utilisation. No equipment will be purchased and no entry fees will be covered until sponsorship funding intended for equipment purchase or fees is deposited into the club account. LM has agreed to contact Eurobodalla Toyota dealer to gain their perspective on the sponsorship arrangement.  <b>Motion:</b> to agree in principle to use sponsorship monies to pay for the local Broulee boat crew entry into the George Bass and Warilla boat race events for the amount of \$860, once sponsorship monies received.  <b>Moved:</b> Lynda McKay  <b>Seconded:</b> Steve Corcoran  <b>Carried.</b>  <b>5.11.5</b> IRB Support for George Bass: The club can provide three (3) IRB to support the event. Committee determined that the Boat Captain needs to establish an IRB crewing roster. There will also need to be a patrol organised for Coila Beach. Repairer indicated excessive wear on tails due to being dragged, mainly on concrete. Suggested most likely due to sand rather than concrete. Could we explore the purchase or acquisition of some new/ second hand carpet in the shed? This will increase its protective footprint as the board quantity has expanded onto the concrete in some areas. Preferred for synthetic grass over carpet.
